


multiple locations, it is easy to miscommunicate without the right system in place.

According to Dodge Data research, more than 40% of owners say that software's inability to conform to how owners run their programs is the top challenge to expanding <u>project</u> <u>management information system</u> (PMIS) usage.

Because of this major obstacle, teams will use systems outside of their PMIS for specific functions. The more work that is done outside of a PMIS, the less productive a team is.
