



Dodge Data Analytics surveyed owners in the construction industry within the healthcare, education, commercial and government sectors; 40% of those reported being limited in their PMIS because it could not be conformed to the way they wanted to run their programs. Up to 75% said they had to conduct specific processes outside of their PMIS because it could not handle all their needs.





This use of multiple tools led to lower productivity, silos of data, the requirement of additional resources, greater training needs and higher overall costs.

The Kahua platform ends these challenges. Customers can be flexible at any time, from specific workflows or reports, new business processes or new fields, functionality or even language and currencies. The app also keeps tabs on the GSA's diversion of construction and demolition waste from landfills, as well as tracks nationwide project scopes, energy performance, LEED certification and compliance with environmental laws.
